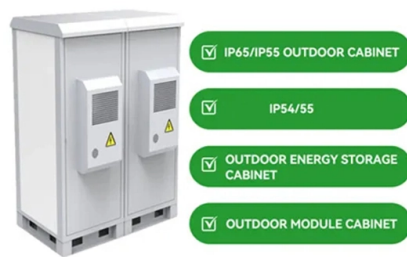


Instructions for entering and exiting optical distribution boxes



Summary of Content

Proper entry and exit of optical distribution boxes require careful cable preparation, secure sealing, organized routing, and correct splice tray management to ensure network integrity and minimize signal loss.

Preparing for Entry

Before entering an ODB, ensure all tools and materials are ready, including cleaning tissues, cable seals, nylon tie-wraps, shrinkable sleeves, and protective tubes (). Inspect all optical cables for damage and clean connectors to prevent contamination (). Identify the main feeder cables and drop cables, noting their designated ports or slots in the box ().

Entering the Box

- **Cable Sealing:** Insert the main cable through the appropriate cable seal and hose clamp, securing the outer sheath and strength members (). Drop cables should be inserted through their respective drop cable seals.
- **Routing:** Route fibers carefully to avoid sharp bends. Use protection tubes for loose buffer tubes and ensure fibers are guided to the splice trays without tension ().
- **Splice Tray Management:** Open the splice tray and place fibers inside according to the tray layout. Secure fibers with holders or heat-shrink sleeves, and ensure splitters or adapters are properly positioned ().
