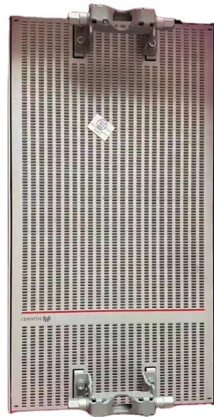

- **Outer Jacket:** Provides durability and environmental protection; materials include PVC, LSZH, OFNR, or OFNP depending on indoor/outdoor use .
- **Connectors:** Common types include LC, SC, ST, FC, MPO/MTP, with simplex (one fiber) or duplex (two fibers) configurations .
