Fiber-Compatible Routers

While standard routers can work with fiber internet through an ONT, fiber optic routers are specifically designed to handle high-speed fiber connections. These routers often include advanced chipsets and high-speed Ethernet ports (e.g., 2.5GbE) to fully utilize fiber internet speeds, which can exceed 10 Gbps. Using a standard cable or DSL router with fiber may limit performance and reduce reliability.

- Router connects to the ONT using an Ethernet cable.
