The third-level distribution box is the distribution box to which the cables drawn from the second-level distribution box are connected. A distribution box is installed under the main distribution box, and a switch box is installed under the distribution box. "Two level protection" mainly refers to the use of leakage protection measures. Note: The three-level power distribution is mainly to ensure that each power-consuming device has electricity available; each power-consuming device can be used.
