An LCFC pigtail is a type of fiber optic pigtail that combines an LC connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to the main fiber cable in the field. Unlike patch cords, which have connectors on both ends, pigtails provide a factory-terminated connector for reliable, low-loss connections while allowing flexible field splicing to incoming fiber.

Single-Mode vs Multimode

- Single-mode (OS2) LCFC pigtails are optimized for long-distance transmission, often supporting distances of 10 km or more with minimal attenuation, making them ideal for backbone, metro, and FTTH networks.
- Multimode (OM1-OM5) LCFC pigtails are better suited for short-distance applications, such as within-building LANs or data centers, due to higher modal dispersion over long distances.

Advantages for Long-Distance Pulling

- Low Insertion Loss and High Return Loss: Factory-polished LC connectors ensure minimal signal degradation, which is critical for long-distance links.
- Fusion Splicing Compatibility: The bare fiber end allows permanent, low-loss splicing to the main fiber, maintaining signal integrity over extended distances.
