Overview of Level 3 Distribution Boxes

Level 3, or tertiary, distribution boxes are the final stage in a three-level power distribution system, typically delivering 220V mains electricity directly to households or individual units in a building . Unlike Level 1 (primary) and Level 2 (secondary) distribution boxes, which handle higher voltages and three-phase power, Level 3 boxes focus on single-phase protection for end-user outlets.

Protective Features

- **Single-Phase Circuit Breakers:** Each outlet or group of outlets is protected by a dedicated single-phase circuit breaker. This prevents overcurrent or short-circuit damage to connected devices .
- **Leakage Protection (Residual Current Devices):** Level 3 boxes often include leakage protection to guard against electric shock. This ensures that if a current leak occurs, the circuit is immediately disconnected, enhancing user safety .
- **Compliance with Standards:** These boxes are designed according to construction and electrical safety standards, ensuring proper insulation, grounding, and protection against environmental factors such as rain or dust .
