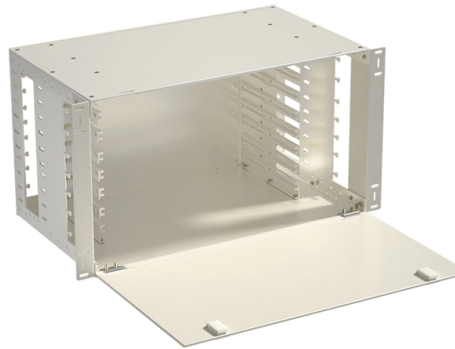


Libya Active Optical Cable DML
