Overview

A low voltage (LV) distribution box is a key component of an electrical distribution system that manages and distributes low-voltage power (typically $\leq 50V$ for certain devices, but commonly 230/400V in building systems) to various circuits within a facility. It houses protective devices such as circuit breakers, residual current devices (RCDs), and fuses, ensuring safety against overloads, short circuits, and electric shocks while centralizing power control for monitoring and maintenance .

Types of LV Distribution Boxes

- **Main Distribution Board (MDB):** Receives power from the main supply and distributes it to sub-circuits. It allows future expansion without major reconfiguration and provides protection for each branch circuit .
- **Sub-Main Distribution Board (SMDB):** Distributes electricity from the MDB to specific zones or systems, such as HVAC or lighting circuits, improving safety and manageability .
- **Final Distribution Box (FDB):** Supplies power directly to end-user devices and appliances. It often includes miniature circuit breakers (MCBs) or RCDs for localized protection .
