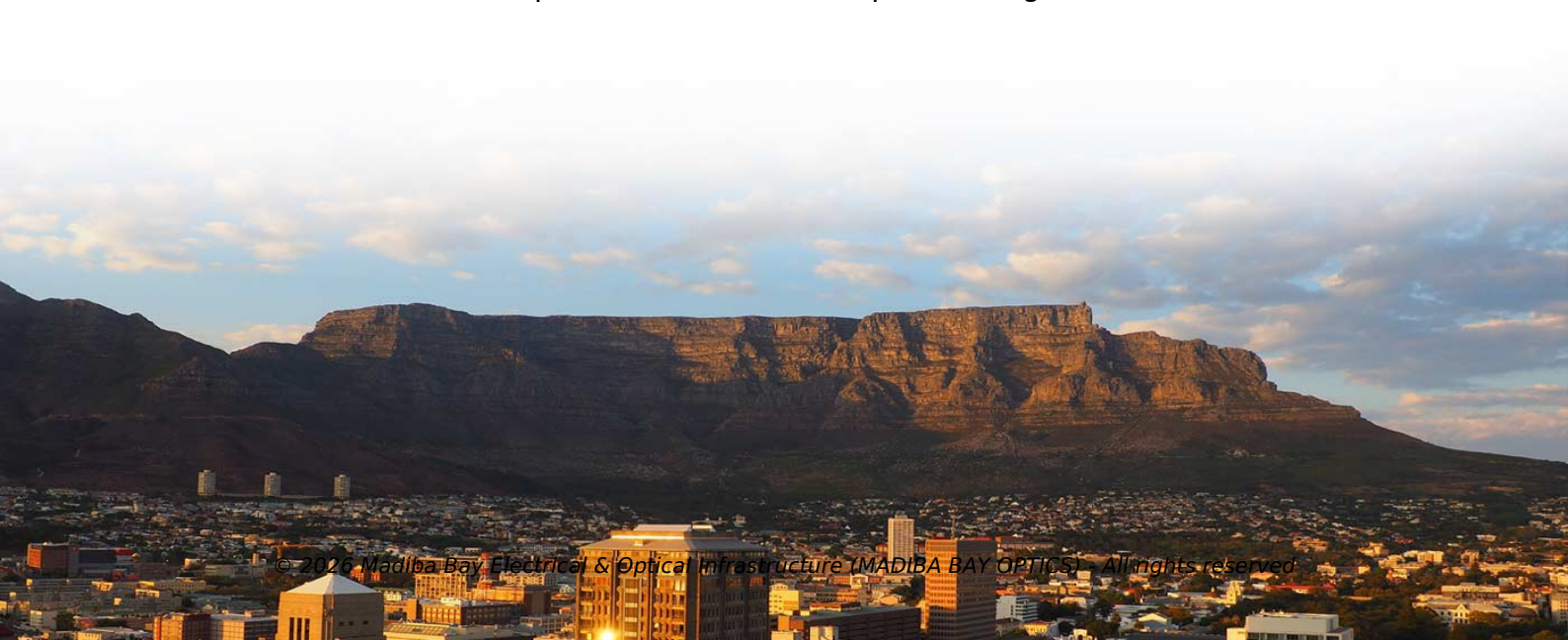


Methods for sealing wiring in distribution boxes
