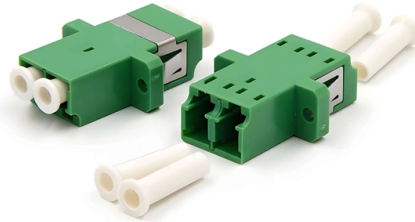

- **2G/3G Networks:** Introduced packet-switching with GPRS, adding nodes like SGSN (Serving GPRS Support Node) and GGSN (Gateway GPRS Support Node) to support mobile internet and data services.
- **4G LTE Networks:** Use the Evolved Packet Core (EPC), which integrates both packet-switched and voice services. Key components include MME (Mobility Management Entity), SGW (Serving Gateway), PGW (Packet Data Network Gateway), HSS (Home Subscriber Server), and PCRF (Policy and Charging Rules Function). EPC supports VoLTE for high-quality IP-based voice calls.
