Overview of Primary Distribution Boxes

A primary distribution box serves as the interface between a transmission or sub-transmission network and the distribution system. It routes electrical power from the substation to secondary distribution substations or directly to large industrial consumers . The voltage level for primary distribution varies by country, but common examples include 66/11 kV or 110/20 kV systems .

Typical Configuration

- High-Voltage Side (HV)
- Usually air-insulated outdoor switchgear or gas-insulated switchgear (GIS).
- Includes circuit breakers, disconnectors, and measuring transformers.
- GIS allows compact installation indoors or underground, integrating HV and medium-voltage (MV) components in one unit .
- Medium-Voltage Side (MV)
- Typically metal-enclosed air-insulated switchgear.
- Houses bus bars, circuit breakers, and protective relays.
