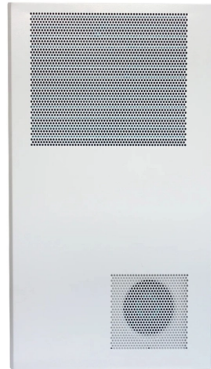


Morocco installs 40G active optical cable



Overview

A major submarine fiber optic cable project is set to link Morocco and Spain's Canary Islands, positioning the archipelago as a strategic telecommunications hub in the Atlantic. Installation will begin in late 2025, marking a significant milestone in Europe-Africa connectivity. Morocco's three national operators – Maroc Telecom. The southern part of the "West Africa" submarine fiber optic cable, affiliated with the Marocain Télécom Group, has been in service since July 2021 and connects Morocco to Ivory Coast, Togo, Benin, Gabon and Mauritania, through seven points. The project is led.
