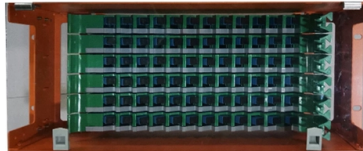


Multiple routers for fiber optic cables

Routers used with fiber optic cables must support Gigabit Ethernet speeds, be compatible with an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), and ideally feature Wi-Fi 5, 6, or 7 for optimal performance.

Key Requirements for Fiber-Ready Routers

- **High-Speed Capability:** The router must support at least Gigabit Ethernet (1000 Mbps) to handle the high bandwidth of fiber connections . For multi-gigabit fiber plans, routers with 10G LAN/WAN ports or LAN aggregation are recommended .
- **WAN Port for ONT:** Fiber connections often require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal into data usable by the router. A fiber-ready router should have a WAN port to connect to the ONT .
- **Advanced Wireless Technology:** Routers with Wi-Fi 5 (AC), Wi-Fi 6 (AX), or Wi-Fi 7 provide faster wireless speeds and better coverage, which is essential to fully utilize fiber internet .
- **Sufficient LAN Ports:** For wired devices like gaming consoles or desktops, a router with at least 4 Gigabit LAN ports is recommended. Some high-end models support LAN aggregation for even faster wired speeds .
- **Optional Built-in Modem or Fiber Interface:** Some routers come with a built-in optical interface or modem, allowing direct connection to fiber without a separate ONT .
