Overview

A neutral link is used to distribute a neutral supply to all the output loads. When single-pole MCBs are used for output loads, the neutral wire of the loads is connected to the neutral link. The earthing terminal of the power supply and loads are connected to the earth. Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the primary source of electrical energy from the mains supply. Neutral (N) Wire Connection: For. Correct circuit breaker wiring configurations are the foundation for the safety, reliability, and overall performance of any electrical distribution system. When the three-phase load is symmetrical, the vector sum of the current flowing into the neutral. According to NEC Article 250, both the neutral and ground wires must be connected only in the main panel or at the first service disconnect.
