

National Requirements for the Color of Distribution Boxes

General Guidelines

While standards like the National Electrical Code (NEC) in the U.S., IEC 60364, and BS 7671 in the UK provide detailed requirements for installation, accessibility, and safety of distribution boxes, they do not prescribe a specific color for the enclosures themselves. Instead, color coding is often used for identification purposes, such as:

- Voltage level: High-voltage and low-voltage enclosures may use different colors to prevent accidental contact.
- Phase identification: In three-phase systems, colored labels or markings may indicate phase (e.g., red, yellow, blue).
- Safety classification: Certain colors may denote emergency circuits, critical systems, or protective distribution systems (PDS) in sensitive facilities.

Common Practices

- Industrial and commercial settings: Gray, metallic, or neutral colors are commonly used for general-purpose distribution boxes, while red or orange may indicate high-voltage or emergency circuits.
