Server rack size – also known as cabinet size – refers to the total size of the racks that house servers in a data center or other hosting facility. Rack size is important because it determines how many servers you can fit inside each rack, as well as which types of servers the rack can. The three primary dimensions to consider are rack height (measured in rack units or U), rack width (most commonly the industry-standard 19-inch format), and rack depth (typically ranging from 24 inches to 48 inches). In real deployments, however, rack size is rarely just a measurement problem.
