- **Longer Transmission Distance:** SC fiber can transmit signals over tens of kilometers without significant loss, whereas copper cables are limited to 100 meters for Ethernet connections .
- **Lower Signal Loss and Interference:** Fiber is immune to electromagnetic interference (EMI) and crosstalk, providing more stable and reliable connections than copper .
