Role of Optical Splitters in PON

In a Passive Optical Network (PON), the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider's central office sends optical signals downstream to multiple subscribers. Optical splitters are passive devices that divide this signal into multiple outputs, allowing a single OLT port to serve many ONUs or ONTs without requiring dedicated fibers for each user. This reduces infrastructure costs, simplifies network expansion, and requires no power or active maintenance.

Splitter Types and Ratios

Two main types of splitters are used:

- FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) Splitters: Low-cost, suitable for small splits like 1:2 or 1:4.
- PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) Splitters: Provide uniform signal distribution, ideal for larger splits such as 1:32 or 1:64. Split ratios determine how the optical power is divided. For example, a 1:32 splitter divides the input signal into 32 outputs, with each output receiving a fraction of the original power. Increasing the split ratio reduces the power per output, typically by about 3 dB for each doubling of the split.
