From there, existing internal wiring can distribute service, or fiber can continue directly to workstations for maximum performance . Identify a central node location for fiber termination and plan vertical and horizontal routing to each floor or office. 3. Choose Indoor Fiber Cable Types:

- Tight-buffered cables: Flexible and durable, ideal for indoor runs in tight spaces .
- Armored cables: Provide extra protection in areas prone to physical damage .
- LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) cables: Ensure fire safety in commercial buildings .
