Optical modules must be stored under controlled temperature, non-condensing humidity, and strict electrostatic discharge protection to maintain performance and reliability.

Temperature Requirements

Optical transceivers are sensitive semiconductor devices, and storage temperature must be carefully controlled to prevent substrate micro-fractures and degradation. Standard storage conditions typically follow Telcordia GR-468-CORE guidelines, which specify safe temperature ranges to avoid thermal shock that can damage Indium Phosphide (InP) substrates and other internal components . Exceeding these limits can accelerate material degradation and lead to failures during deployment.

Humidity Control

Non-condensing humidity is critical for optical module storage. Excess moisture can penetrate the module, increasing Avalanche Photodiode (APD) dark current, which elevates bit error rates and may cause link failures . Maintaining low, stable humidity prevents moisture ingress and protects sensitive optoelectronic components, ensuring long-term link reliability.
