Characteristics of Direct-Buried Optical Cables

- **Corrosion and moisture resistance:** Special materials and water-blocking designs, including gel-filled or gel-free water-blocked tubes, protect fibers from soil acidity, humidity, and chemical exposure .
- **Weather and environmental durability:** Outer jackets are designed to withstand temperature variations and long-term exposure to soil conditions .
- **High-bandwidth capability:** Using optical fibers, these cables support high-speed data transmission for modern communication networks .

Common Constructions

- **Loose-tube cables:** Fibers are housed in gel-blocked or water-swell tubes, providing protection against microbending and water intrusion. These are widely used for long outdoor runs .
