- **Protection:** Equipped with circuit breakers, fuses, and relays, it safeguards equipment and personnel from overloads, short circuits, and faults.
- **Control and monitoring:** It allows operators to manage power flow, isolate sections for maintenance, and monitor electrical parameters such as current, voltage, and frequency.
