Overview

PON (Passive Optical Network) is a passive optical access network based on optical fibers. Its core feature is that no power supply equipment is required between the OLT (Optical Line Terminal) and the ONU (Optical Network Unit), and signal transmission is achieved only. A passive optical network (PON) or Gigabit Passive Optical Network (GPON) is a point-to-multipoint (P2MP) network that uses a combination of active transmission equipments and passive cable components to provide network connectivity to end user's devices. In practice, PONs are typically used for the last mile between Internet service providers (ISP) and their customers. It has been deployed on a large scale in China since 2006, expanding from initial residential and commercial user access to large.
