Maintenance Program Components

- **Startup and Commissioning:** New relay installations require thorough startup and commissioning to verify correct operation within the protection scheme.
- **Periodic Inspection and Testing:** Maintenance intervals depend on relay type:
 - **Electromechanical relays:** Typically 1-6 years.
 - **Microprocessor-based relays:** Can extend to 10 years or more with self-diagnostics and real-time monitoring.
- **Testing Procedures:**
 - Functional testing using secondary injection or simulation of fault conditions.
