Overview

Construction site temporary installations must use 110V CTE for portable tools, IP-rated distribution boards, 30 mA RCD protection on every circuit, and quarterly EICR inspections. A temporary distribution box, also referred to as a portable power distribution panel, is a movable electrical assembly engineered to safely distribute power from a primary supply to various power tools, machinery and site equipment on construction worksites. The distribution box shall be made of iron plate or other fire-proof insulating materials to achieve ventilation, heat dissipation, rain proof and fire-proof. However, exposure to weather, frequent relocation, rough use and other conditions not normally encountered with conventional wiring systems necessitate special consideration not required in other applications or in completed structures.
