General Installation Guidelines

Secondary distribution boxes distribute power from a primary source to multiple circuits safely. Proper installation ensures fire prevention, system reliability, and compliance with codes. Key considerations include:

- **Enclosure Selection:** Choose boxes with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings for indoor or outdoor use. Steel enclosures are preferred for durability, while plastic is suitable for indoor environments .
- **Placement:** Install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at a height of ~1.5 meters for wall-mounted boxes .
- **Cable Management:** Maintain neat wiring, secure cables, and ensure proper insulation. Use wireways or pull boxes with minimum dimensions (e.g., 300 mm width for vertical bus extensions, 450 mm for horizontal, and 900 W x 1800 H x 800 D for wall-mounted mid-run pull boxes), .

Wiring and Conductor Requirements

- **Wire Sizing:** Select conductors based on load current, voltage, and distance. Minimum LV distributor cable size is typically 185 mm² Aluminium, and HV cable is 150 mm² Aluminium for substations .
