

Safety Requirements for Communication Optical Cables



Summary of Content

Proper handling of fiber optic cables requires adherence to regulatory standards, use of personal protective equipment, careful chemical handling, and safe disposal of fiber scraps.

Regulatory Compliance

When working with fiber optic cables, it is essential to follow applicable standards and regulations. In the U.S., these include OSHA 29 CFR 1910.268 for telecommunications, the National Electrical Safety Code (NESC), and the National Electrical Code (NEC/NFPA 70), which govern safe installation, operation, and maintenance of electrical and communication lines. Compliance with company-specific safety protocols is also critical to ensure a safe work environment .

Eye and Light Safety

Fiber optic systems often use infrared light, which is invisible to the human eye. Directly looking into a live fiber can cause eye injury, even if the power levels are lower than those used in laser surgery. Always verify that fibers are dark using a power meter before inspection, and wear safety glasses with side shields or goggles with infrared filters when working near active fibers . Avoid using microscopes without proper infrared protection.

Handling Fiber Glass

The glass core of fiber optic cables is fragile and can produce sharp shards. To prevent injury:
