

Safety Signage Regulations for Electrical Distribution Boxes



Overview

The National Fire Protection Association's (NFPA) 79 standard requires enclosures that do not clearly show that they contain electrical devices to be marked with a safety sign in accordance with the ANSI Z535 standards. Given that these standards made the older OSHA sign formats obsolete in 2002. According to the Electrical Safety Foundation International (ESFI), the majority of electrical fatalities occur in electrician and construction occupations, followed by installation, maintenance, and repair occupations.
