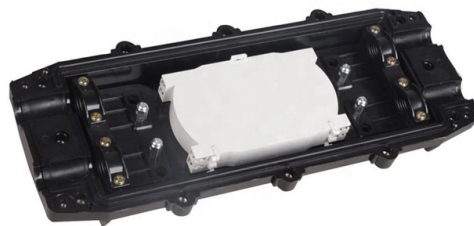


Second-level Construction Engineer Electrical Distribution Box Circuit Diagram

The legend is a list of the symbols to be used on SPU electrical design drawings (Figure B-1). The symbols are based on National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA), Industrial Control Systems (ICS), and American National Standards Institute (ANSI) Standard Y32. A distribution board or distribution box is where the main power supply is distributed to multiple loads.
