Overview of Secondary Protection

Secondary protection relays are designed to monitor power distribution systems for abnormal conditions, such as overcurrents, short circuits, or equipment malfunctions, and to initiate corrective actions that restore normal operation while protecting personnel and equipment (ABB) . Unlike primary protection, which acts immediately to isolate faults, secondary protection provides backup and supplementary protection, ensuring reliability if primary relays fail or if faults are not cleared promptly.

Functions and Operation

Secondary relays perform several critical functions:

- Fault Detection: Identify abnormal currents, voltages, or system behaviors.
- Trip Commands: Send signals to circuit breakers to isolate faulty sections.
- Measurement and Supervision: Monitor system parameters for operational insights.
