Heavy-duty applications require materials with high tensile strength, such as galvanized or stainless steel, while lighter loads may be supported by aluminum or wire mesh trays . 3. Corrosion Resistance

- Galvanized Steel: Economical and durable, suitable for general indoor and outdoor use, but may corrode in highly acidic or saline environments .
- Stainless Steel: Offers superior corrosion resistance, especially grades like AISI 316L, ideal for chemical plants, coastal areas, or high-moisture environments .
- Aluminum: Lightweight, rust-resistant, and suitable for outdoor installations; performs well in atmospheric conditions but may be less strong than steel .
