A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. Also called an electrical distribution box, power distribution box or DB box, it helps organize electrical connections, isolate circuits and protect wiring. The distribution box (DB box) helps safely and efficiently distribute electrical power. But what exactly is a power distribution box, and why is it so essential in our daily lives?
