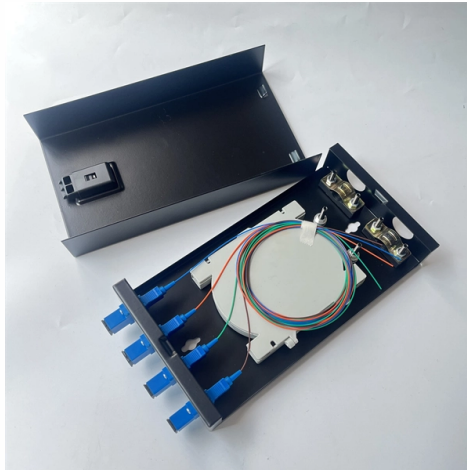

Overview

A fiber optic pigtail is a short cable with a connector on one end and an exposed fiber on the other, designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to a trunk or distribution cable inside a splice tray or fiber distribution box . In a dual-core pigtail, the fiber contains two separate cores within a single jacket, allowing simultaneous transmission of two optical signals through one cable, which is useful for applications requiring redundancy or dual-channel communication .

Key Features

- **Single-Head Connector:** Only one end has a factory-installed connector (LC, SC, ST, FC, or E2000), ensuring low insertion loss and high return loss .
- **Dual-Core Fiber:** Contains two optical cores, enabling two independent optical paths in a single fiber jacket.
- **Fiber Type:** Available in single-mode (OS2) for long-distance or carrier networks, and multimode (OM3/OM4) for in-building or data center applications .
- **Buffer Diameter:** Common diameters include 0.9 mm, 2.0 mm, and 3.0 mm, which should match the splice tray or closure used .
- **Jacket Options:** PVC, LSZH, armored, or outdoor-rated jackets are available depending on environmental requirements .
