Incoming Cable and Lug Specifications

Knockout Dimensions for Cable Entry

Distribution boxes feature removable gland plates and knockouts to allow flexible cable entry:

- Single inside knockouts: 25 mm, 27 mm, 32 mm, 38 mm
- Double inside/outside knockouts: 38/46 mm, 50/63 mm These knockouts are designed to accommodate standard conduit sizes and cable diameters, ensuring proper strain relief and safe routing of incoming lines.
