

Spacing between distribution boxes and main distribution boxes



Summary of Content

Main distribution boxes should maintain at least 1 inch of air spacing and 2 inches over surfaces for feeder circuits, with additional clearances per NEC for safe access and operation.

UL and Electrical Standards

For industrial control panels, UL508A specifies that feeder circuits require 1 inch of spacing through air and 2 inches over surfaces at 600V between uninsulated live parts and grounded or opposite-polarity parts . Listed Power Distribution Blocks (UL1953) meet these spacing requirements directly, while recognized terminal blocks (UL1059) must be verified for spacing suitability based on their group classification (A, C, or D) and amperage ratings . These standards ensure safe operation and prevent short circuits or arcing.

NEC Clearance Requirements

The National Electrical Code (NEC 110.26) mandates that electrical panels, including main distribution boxes, have a working space of at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the panel . This clearance allows safe access for maintenance and operation. Additionally, dedicated space from the floor to 6 feet is required, and panel doors must open fully to 90° . Equipment in front of the panel should not extend more than 6 inches beyond the panelboard face.
