Cabinet Types

- **Open-Frame Racks:** Simple metal frames without doors or side panels, ideal for secure server rooms or labs where maximum airflow and easy access are needed, but they offer no dust or noise protection .
- **Enclosed Cabinets:** Fully enclosed with doors, side panels, and often locks, providing dust protection, noise reduction, and enhanced security. Suitable for home, office, or shared spaces .

Dimensions and Capacity

- **Height:** Measured in rack units (U), where 1U = 1.75 inches (44.45 mm). Common sizes include 6U, 12U, 24U, and 42U, with 42U being standard for enterprise server rooms .
- **Width:** Standardized at 19 inches (EIA-310 standard), ensuring compatibility with most networking equipment .
- **Depth:** Typically ranges from 600mm to 1200mm, accommodating shallow switches to deep-chassis servers and allowing space for cable management and PDUs .
