

# Standards for optical cable lengths

### Fiber Types and Transmission Distances

Multi-mode fibers, including OM1, OM2, OM3, and OM4, are typically used for shorter distances, such as LAN backbones or campus networks, with maximum ranges from a few hundred meters up to 2 kilometers depending on the fiber grade and network speed .

### Factors Affecting Cable Length

The effective length of an optical cable is influenced by:

- **Attenuation:** Signal loss measured in decibels per kilometer (dB/km). Lower attenuation allows longer transmission distances .
- **Dispersion:** Temporal spreading of light pulses, which can degrade signal quality over distance. Fibers with optimized dispersion characteristics support higher-speed transmissions over longer distances .
- **Environmental conditions:** Temperature, humidity, and mechanical stress can affect fiber performance, and standards provide guidelines for these factors .
