The state of distribution boxes in a grid is updated dynamically using real-time measurements and state estimation, with timing dependent on sensor deployment, communication systems, and grid operator protocols.

Real-Time Monitoring and Updates

Distribution boxes, or feeders in a state grid, are monitored using a combination of smart meters, phasor measurement units (PMUs), and other sensors. These devices provide measurements of voltage, current, and power flow, which are transmitted to the grid operator. The update frequency depends on the type of measurement: PMUs can provide data at rates up to 30-60 samples per second, while smart meters typically report at intervals ranging from 1 minute to 15 minutes, depending on the utility's configuration .
