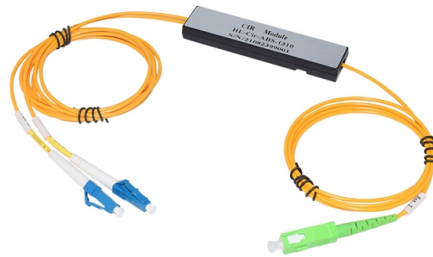


Stripping and fixing of optical cables

- **Layer-by-Layer Stripping:**
 - **Outer Jacket:** Use a wire or fiber optic jacket stripper to remove the outer sheath without nicking the underlying layers.
 - **Strength Members:** Carefully cut or pull away aramid yarns, ensuring the fiber remains undamaged.
 - **Buffer Coating:** Use a precision fiber optic stripper to remove the buffer and acrylate coatings down to the glass cladding (typically 125 μm) without scratching or nicking the fiber.
