The national standard GB50303 clearly stipulates: It is strictly forbidden to lay strong and weak power cables in the same pipe, the parallel spacing must be $\geq 300\text{mm}$, and the angle should be $\geq 60^\circ$ when crossing to reduce coupling interference. Strong current cables carry high voltage and high current. While it is technically possible to run power and low-voltage cables in the same tray under strict conditions, segregation or shielding is strongly recommended to ensure safety, compliance, and system.
