Distribution boxes are organized in three levels—primary, secondary, and tertiary—each with specific switches and protection devices suited to the load and application.

Overview of Distribution Levels

- Primary Distribution (Level 1)
 - Connects directly to the low-voltage side of the transformer (typically 0.4 kV) and serves as the main distribution cabinet.
 - Contains isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors to manage large incoming power safely.
 - Not intended for direct use by electrical equipment; it mainly protects and distributes power to secondary boxes .
- Secondary Distribution (Level 2)
 - Receives power from the primary distribution cabinet and distributes it to buildings or units.
 - Equipped with large three-phase circuit breakers and sometimes leakage protection switches.
 - Designed for three-phase loads such as air conditioning, water heaters, or industrial equipment.
 - Typically installed about 1.5 meters above the ground for accessibility .
- Tertiary Distribution (Level 3)
 - The final distribution point before reaching individual appliances or households.
