Overview

Optical splitters in the outside plant (OSP) are used mostly in passive optical networks (PONs) for fiber-to-the-user (FTTx) networks, and are often overlooked as failure points. The first step, as per best practices, would be to check the optical ports of the ONT that is down and the optical connectors of the fiber jumper between. Or it could be caused by the quality of the connector itself, such as poor end-face geometry that doesn't pass the parameters defined by IEC PAS 61755-3 standards, including angle of the polish, fiber height, radius of curvature or apex offset. Their performance depends on optical symmetry, waveguide integrity, and mechanical stability of. Testing a splitter or other passive fiber optic devices like switches is little different from testing a patchcord or cable plant using the two industry standard tests, OFSTP-14 for double-ended loss (connectors on both ends) or FOTP-171 for single-ended testing.
