

# The grounding of the distribution box is hot

### Causes of a Hot Ground

- **Open Neutral Connection:** If the neutral wire is broken or disconnected, current may flow through the ground wire instead of the neutral, energizing the grounding system .
- **Improper Bonding:** Neutral and ground conductors should only be bonded at the main service panel. Bonding downstream in sub-panels or junction boxes can cause operational current to flow on the ground wire .
- **Miswiring or Reversed Polarity:** Swapping hot and neutral wires or using a "bootleg" ground can energize the ground wire, making metal casings live .
- **Loose or Corroded Connections:** Poor contact at grounding points, especially in stainless steel enclosures, can increase resistance and cause localized heating .

### Safety Risks

A hot ground can energize the metal parts of the distribution box, creating a shock hazard for anyone touching it. It can also lead to fire hazards if the current is sustained . Immediate action is required to prevent injury or equipment damage.
