Mechanical Switches

Push-Button Switches are widely used for manual operation in industrial machinery. They can be momentary (active only while pressed) or maintained (latched until pressed again) and are often used for start/stop functions or emergency stops due to their visibility and accessibility . Toggle Switches operate via a lever that moves back and forth to open or close a circuit. They are durable and simple, commonly used in control panels and automotive applications . Rotary Switches use a rotating mechanism to select one of multiple circuit positions, ideal for multi-speed motors or selecting operational modes . Rocker Switches function similarly to toggle switches but with a rocking motion, often used in industrial control panels for on/off operations . Foot Switches allow hands-free operation, with momentary or maintained configurations, commonly used in machinery where operators need both hands free . Limit Switches detect the presence or position of objects, providing safety and automation control by triggering actions when a mechanical part reaches a set point .
