

The router's fiber optic indicator light is not working

If your router's fiber optic light is not on, it usually indicates a lack of signal, power, or a connection issue between your router and the fiber network.

Check Power and Connections

First, ensure the router and Optical Network Terminal (ONT) are powered on. Verify that the power cables are securely plugged into both the devices and a working wall outlet, and try a different outlet if necessary. If the router is connected via Ethernet to the ONT, make sure the cable is firmly seated and not damaged.

Inspect the Fiber Signal

The fiber light (often labeled PON or Fiber) should be solid green when receiving a proper signal. If it is off or red, this indicates no fiber signal is being received, which could be caused by a physical fiber disconnection, a dirty or damaged connector, a broken patch cord, or an issue from the ISP. Check that the fiber cable is properly connected and free from bends or damage.

Router and ONT Status

- Power light off: The router or ONT may not be receiving power. Confirm the devices are plugged in and powered on.
- Ethernet connection light off: The ONT may not detect a connection to the router. Try a different Ethernet cable or port.
