Summary of Content

Elevator machine rooms may contain multiple distribution boxes, but all circuits must primarily serve elevator-related equipment, with proper disconnects and code-compliant installation.

NEC Requirements for Machine Room Circuits

Each elevator car, machine room, and hoistway pit must have dedicated branch circuits for lighting, receptacles, and HVAC systems. These circuits are protected by overcurrent devices located in the machine room or control space, and disconnects must be lockable and externally operable to ensure safety during maintenance (NEC Article 620.51) . Lighting circuits in the machine room are not required to be GFCI-protected, but receptacles must have GFCI protection to safeguard maintenance personnel .

Placement and Number of Distribution Boxes

For machine rooms serving multiple elevators, it is common to install a panelboard or distribution board that consolidates circuits for all elevators. Each elevator may also require separate disconnects near the machine room door for quick access, especially in jurisdictions like NYC . These disconnects can be fused switches or circuit breakers and must be accessible to qualified personnel.
