The power distribution box at your house entrance is the main service panel, which receives electricity from the utility and distributes it safely to all circuits in your home.

Overview of the Service Entrance

The service entrance is where electricity from the utility company enters your home. It typically includes the electric meter, which measures energy usage, and the service panel (also called the breaker box or load center), which houses the main disconnect and individual circuit breakers or fuses (). Power can enter via overhead service drops or underground cables, depending on your local utility setup ().

Components of the Distribution Box

- **Main Breaker:** Controls the overall power supply to the house and allows you to shut off electricity in emergencies ().
- **Bus Bars:** Two 120-volt “hot” legs feed the panel, providing standard 120V circuits and 240V for high-demand appliances like stoves or dryers ().
- **Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits by interrupting power if an overload or short circuit occurs ().
- **Neutral and Ground Connections:** The neutral wire carries return current, and the grounding system (connected to a rod or water pipe) stabilizes voltage and provides a safe path for stray currents ().
