For commercial office or light-duty applications, such as LAN, data, or control wiring, tray thicknesses generally range from 1.2 mm to 1.6 mm. These trays are suitable for moderate cable loads and shorter spans, typically up to 2 meters between supports. For heavier-duty commercial installations, including power distribution or multi-layer cable arrangements, thicker trays of 2.0 mm are commonly used. These provide greater structural strength and reduce the risk of sagging over longer spans or when supporting multiple cables.

Factors Influencing Thickness Selection

- **Span Length:** Longer unsupported spans require thicker trays to prevent deflection. For spans of 2.5–3 meters, a thickness of 2.5 mm or more is recommended.
- **Cable Load:** The cumulative weight of installed cables, including potential future additions, determines the minimum required thickness. Heavier power cables necessitate thicker trays.
- **Material and Environment:** Stainless steel or galvanized trays in corrosive or outdoor environments often require 2.0 mm or higher thickness for durability and corrosion resistance.
