The Trapeze or swing support is the most common type. Thread hex nut 25 mm (1") to 50 mm (2") above location of the tray bottom. The cross member comes next followed by a second set of square washers. All vertical hangers will project through the cross. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
