- Choose cables with durable jackets and protective layers to prevent signal loss and frequent failures in harsh factory conditions.

Pre-terminated fiber optic cables come factory-assembled with connectors such as LC, SC, ST, or MTP/MPO, ready for plug-and-play installation . Benefits include:
